Theses

This is a new section of *RCL*, which we hope will become a regular feature of the journal. We plan to list all doctoral theses on the subject of religion in communist lands published throughout the world. In the three issues of Vol. 13, we plan to publish a list of theses published up to mid-1983 (the earliest is dated 1930). From Vol. 14 onwards, we hope to update this list regularly.

For ease of reference, the list has been subdivided according to subject. The list is subdivided, first by country, secondly by denomination, and thirdly by author's surname in alphabetical order. In this issue we print the following sections from the USSR category: Orthodoxy, Old Believers, Catholicism and Protestantism. Other sections on the USSR, and sections on other countries, will follow. The list will conclude with other sections which do not fit in to the country/ denomination scheme.

Some titles appear in more than one section, for ease of reference. They are indicated by an asterisk. All theses are for the PhD degree unless otherwise indicated. In a few cases, a short explanation of the thesis title has been added if its relevance to the section in which it is included is not immediately obvious. The abstract number appended to each entry refers to *Dissertation Abstracts International*; the items refer to the volume, issue and page number of a particular abstract.

Compiler's note

Unfortunately, identification of a promising dissertation often is only a modest first step towards a reading of it. While the subject of availability goes beyond the scope of the present project, several suggestions are in order. A very able handling of this vexing problem is to be found in Frank J. Shulman's *Doctoral Dissertations on Japan and Korea, 1969-1974* (Ann Arbor: Michigan: University Microfilms, 1976), pp. 413-23. The country by country survey of the "Availability of Dissertations" includes a knowledgeable description of the *unavailability* of Soviet theses (pp. 419-20) contributed by Patricia Polansky of the University of Hawaii at Manoa. (See also the thorough examination of "Soviet Dissertation Lists since 1934" by Eleanor Buist in *The Library Journal* 33 (April, 1978) is disappointing and awkardly translated.)

Since Soviet theses may be examined only in the USSR, and then with no predictability, their inclusion in the present list requires explanation. Beyond the fact that Soviet interest in particular topics is instructive, the findings of Soviet dissertations are usually published in article or book form. Thus an author's name serves as a lead to a published treatment of his or her research. Finally, *avtoreferaly*, theses abstracts of twenty to sixty pages, are more accessible than the dissertations themselves and some of these have found their way into western collections.
